Father Zynel was born on January 6, 1933, and ordained to the priesthood on June 21, 1959, for the Archdiocese of Bialystok, Poland passed away on June 17, 2014 at the age of 81. He came to the Archdiocese of Edmonton in March 1974 and served parishes throughout the Archdiocese for over 25 years until his retirement in 1999. He continued to assist in parishes celebrating the sacraments until 2006, when he returned to Bialystok, Poland, to live at a residence for retired priests.

The funeral will be held Friday, June 20, in the Catholic parish of Wisilkowie, Poland. Let us pray in gratitude for the repose of his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed.
