First Reconciliation and First Communion *both now happen in grade two*. First Reconciliation registration in the fall (**September 23rd**) and first Communion registration in the winter (January 20th 2015)

Do you want your child to receive First Reconciliation? Here's how! Preparing children for a Catholic sacrament is a group effort that involves parents, St. Vital Catholic Parish, St. Andre Academy, Ecole Bellevue School, Ecole Dansereau, Ecole Francophone Beaumont and Ecole Beau Meadow School. Everyone has a role!

As a parent, you are the primary teacher of the faith for your child. As you know, the sacraments are celebrated and lived in the parish. Because of this, the preparation for the celebration of the sacraments takes place in the parish. Sacramental preparation registration takes place at the parish, not at the schools. The schools support what takes place in the home and parish and are a place for children to learn about Jesus Christ and develop a relationship with him.
