Weekly Reflection – the Road to Discipleship

Sunday, November 2 — Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls’ Day)

“Come to me all you that are weary and carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.” Life is hard, interspersed with too fleeting moments of happiness. Everyone longs for a place to rest, a place of peace. Our bodies may get tired, or sick, or frail; our spirits may become sad, hurt, or discouraged. Adding one more ‘weight’—Jesus’ yoke—to our burdens seems dumb. Jesus’ yoke, however, is living fully the grace of our baptism among a community of believers. That yoke marks us as “a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people” within which our burdens can be shared.
