Sunday, January 18 - Second Sunday in Ordinary Time The Road to Discipleship: Christian Unity

Sunday is the highpoint of each week's work, prayer, faith, hope, joy and suffering, and the start of another week living as a disciple of Christ. **January 18** begins the world-wide Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The eight-day period (called an "octAvenue") is always celebrated from January 18-25, which are both Sundays this year. Working to restore unity among all Christians is called being ecumenical. Jesus prays that we will be one as he and the Father are one—so that all people may come to believe in Christ (John 17:21). This week, pray daily for unity among all Christians. Our unity with the Holy Trinity is essential to being a disciple of Christ.

Online Faith Formation Courses
