Sunday, March 15 - Fourth Sunday of Lent The Road to Discipleship: Lifted Up

In Numbers 21:4-9, Moses lifted a bronze serpent upon a pole as a remedy for unfaithful Israel. God promised to save anyone who looked for mercy at the creature lifted on the pole. Jesus understands this story as an image of his own crucifixion and the healing it will bring to a rebellious world. When Jesus speaks of the Son of Man being lifted up, he refers to the Paschal Mystery: Jesus will be lifted up on the Cross, from the grave, and into heaven. Unbelief is a form of rebellion keeping people in darkness and sin. Living the Paschal Mystery through Jesus Christ is the way of discipleship bringing one into the light and eternal life with God.
